Ceramics II

Prerequisites: Ceramics I

Level: 10th grade - 12th grade

Credits: 0.5

Course Description

This course is a semester course concerned with further developing hand-building techniques. The design of advanced containers and free form sculptures will be emphasized. Students will continue to work on major sculptural forms in media such as clay, plaster, paper mache, and assemblage. Instruction in the materials, techniques, equipment, vocabulary and history of sculptural art is given. Emphasis on deeper understanding, craftsmanship, aesthetics, personal expression and historical analysis.

This course will be offered in conjunction with Ceramics I.
